

CONTESTS FOR STUDENTS

Principals are requested to use their discretion in determining which contest are to be permitted in their schools and which ones are to be prohibited. Generally, the contests that are allowed should be voluntary. Only on rare occasions should an entire class be required to enter poster, writing, or speaking contests, and then only if it fits in with the class objective and the teacher's lesson plans. In the secondary schools, basic guides for decisions on such matters shall be the rules, regulations, resolutions, and policies of the West Virginia Board of Education and the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission.
