## COUNTY-WIDE GRADING SYSTEM Grades K-12

- 1. In order to meet requirements of WV State Board Policy 2515, and to create a uniform grading scale for Monroe County, the following grading scale is adopted.
- 2. Effective Date: September 1, 2003
- In addition, this policy requires that schools provide parents with a numerical score for a "grade" each grading period, with information indicating the letter grade designation on the report card, so that parents and students can better appreciate the student's progress in a particular class. Except for the 2003-04 school year, during which time schools shall use letter grades for grades K-6.
- 4. Beginning with the class of 2007, this grading system shall also affect the calculation of graduation honors, with those honors being designated based upon the numerical average of each class for high school credit.
- 5. The following numerical, letter and quality points will be awarded:

| 93-100 | Α | 4.0 |

- 6. The above scale shall apply to grades 7-12 for the 2003-04 school year and thereafter.
- 7. The above scale shall apply to grades 5-6 for the 2004-05 school year and thereafter.
- 8. This policy shall replace all previous policies related to grading scales.
- 9. For grades K-4, the previous grading scale, which follows, remains in place:
