

DRIVER TRAINING

Driver education is a formal classroom and laboratory course which includes both classroom and practice driving instruction. Both phases are to be pursued concurrently to accommodate and assure effective articulation of the concepts involved.

The purposes of the classroom phase of the driver education are to develop the knowledge and attitudes essential to the establishment of appropriate driver behavior and the development of an understanding of solutions to problems resulting from unsafe driving practices.

The appropriate time for formal driver education instruction is at the time the student reaches legal driving age. The student must reach the legal driving age before the semester for which he/she is enrolled ends.

Driver training is included in the curriculum of the county high schools during the regular school term.
