Teachers are urged to visit the homes of their pupils, especially the homes of those doing poor school work. Teachers new to the Monroe County System and area are especially encouraged to familiarize themselves with local people and customs. A knowledge of the home conditions, economy, occupations, and way of life in the community from which the pupils come, can do a great deal to increase the effectiveness of a teacher in the classroom.

As a part of their assignment, guidance counselors should, if possible, visit the homes or arrange conferences with parents of pupils with special problems who are making unsatisfactory progress.
