

HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

Home or hospital instruction shall be provided:

1. To any child with a health or physical impairment which, in the opinion of a licensed medical examiner, will cause him/her to be absent from school for more than two consecutive weeks and who school personnel determine if they can educationally benefit from such a program, or
To any child whose educational needs, as determined by a case study and reviewed in a multi-disciplinary staff conference, are most appropriately and effectively met by such a program.

The amount of instructional or supportive service provided through the home and hospital program shall be determined in relation to each child's educational needs and his physical and mental health.

Application forms for children desiring homebound instruction may be obtained at the office of the Director of Special Education, Board of Education Office, Union, WV.

This form must be completed by the pupil's physician and returned to the Director of Special Education before a teacher can be assigned to the pupil.
