

INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES – BUS USE

The sponsor of all school activities held away from home, shall be responsible for returning all participants to the school after such events.

However, a parent or guardian may be permitted to take his/her child provided the sponsor is presented with a written request assuming the responsibility for the student involved. Such request is to be handed to the sponsor by the parent or guardian, at the end of the event, on the appropriate form.

Bus Use–Extra Curricular: Only participants are permitted to ride the buses along with the chaperones who are Board employees. Cheerleaders are included as participants. It is permissible to use school patrons as chaperones provided they have been approved by the Board of Education. It is a requirement that an eligible adult be on each bus as a chaperone. Abuse of this privilege will result in suspension of the use of buses for this purpose.

Bus operators will be instructed not to operate buses unless all requirements are met.

Sponsoring organizations shall pay all driver costs for all extracurricular bus trips. Bus trips in excess of 300 miles round trip require advance Board approval.
