The Monroe County Board of Education recognizes that one of the best sources of continuing insights into being a good Board member is provided through membership in the state and national school boards associations. Consequently, when a majority of the Board votes to join the West Virginia School Boards Association and the National School Boards Association the annual dues may be paid through the expenditure of county funds. In addition, Board members may be reimbursed for actual traveling expenses to attend West Virginia School Boards Association meetings.
