

STUDENT FEES, FINES AND CHARGES

The collection of fees as such from students in the public schools of Monroe County shall be prohibited. The purchase of materials by students for personal use in such classes as home economics, industrial arts, physical educations, etc. is permitted; however, the price charged students shall be no more than the actual cost of items received.

Small fines may be assessed pupils for overdue library books, but in no case should the cost exceed the cost of replacing the book. Fines should not be used as a form of punishment for misconduct or bad behavior.

Each high school shall furnish each graduate with two transcripts of credit free of charge, upon request of the student, and each student shall pay the school \$1.00 for each transcript issued in excess of two.

Students have the responsibility to look after and care for the school equipment and supplies which the taxpayers have provided. They shall be held accountable and be charged for replacing or repairing damaged, lost, or destroyed supplies, equipment, or learning material for which they are personally responsible.
