

STUDENT INSURANCE PROGRAMS

The Board of Education shall provide the pupils or their parents with the opportunity to purchase pupil accident insurance. A commercial insurance company shall be selected by the Board who shall offer a group accident policy to all enrolled pupils.

The principal shall provide time at the beginning of each school year for the enrollment of pupils desiring to purchase the insurance. The principal shall also see to it that the premiums are paid by the pupil and that the total amount of premiums due from his/her school is sent to the insurance company.

The principal or a teacher designated by him/her is responsible for seeing that all claim forms are properly filled in and signed by a school official.

For the past several years, the Board of Education has designated the Pilot Life Insurance Company, Greensboro, North Carolina to handle pupil accident insurance.
