TEXTBOOK SELECTION AND ADOPTION

Textbooks at the elementary level are adopted by the Board of Education upon the recommendation of the Superintendent with the aid of a committee of teachers not to exceed five members. Selections of textbooks are made from a State multiple list.

At the secondary level, textbooks are adopted by the Board upon the recommendation of the Superintendent with the aid of a committee of teaches from the subject area under consideration for a change in texts.

Prior to Board adoption, the elementary and secondary textbook recommendations shall be reviewed by an advisory committee comprised of ten parents. This committee is to be selected by school principals, subject to Board approval on the basis of one parent per elementary or secondary school.
