I. Roll Call

- a. Mr. Lively called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

XII. Discussion Items

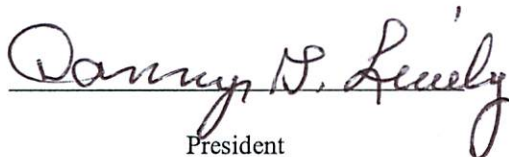
- a. Mr. Lively distributed an article from the Raleigh Register regarding changes in education.
