Dual Enrollment/ Career Certification Opportunities

COLLEGE CREDIT!

Completers of this program will earn up to 6 hours of college credit from Concord University. Students will be exempt from taking the course/s below required for teacher education programs. Students are also eligible for a voucher to take the Praxis test while in high school. Passing scores on this test are required for admission to teacher education programs across the state.

- EDUC 210
- *EDSP 265

*Applies to students pursuing special education or elementary education degrees.

The following requirements will be waived for admission to the Teacher Education program at Concord University:

- Admission to teacher education portfolio
- Documentation of 75 volunteer hours working with children

Note – All college credits and teacher education program waivers are valid for three years following program completion date.

INDUSTRY CREDENTIALS!

Completers of this program can earn the career industry credentials below.

- CPR and First Aid Certifications
- ECCATC Certification (must earn 150 hrs)
- Eligibility to sit for the substitute aide test

EMBEDDED CREDIT!

Completers of this program earn a high school English credit.
